  - e. Group voted and agreed to Banquet date of Thursday February 24<sup>th</sup>. Christine will get contract for Wood Hall on that date. Mike will be the contract contact. All members should make their societies aware of the banquet date.
  - f. Christine open discussion on student presentations to increase student banquet attendance. Idea of student presentations was well received at SWE meeting. We discussed if cocktail hour should be lengthened by 30 minutes to allow for attendees to circulate to presentation. Not all members were sure that student presentation would be well received/well visited. How best to draw students to banquet was discussed. Each member society will need to solicit their student sections for attendance.
